

# **DRESS CODE & SHORTS POLICY**

## **Georgia PGA Section Tournaments:**

(Chapters and Division Dress Code at the Bottom)

### **Players:**

While on the host facility property, players shall present a neat appearance in both clothing and personal grooming. Blue jeans, shorts, cutoffs, T-shirts or shirts with no collar shall not be worn.

### **Practice Rounds:**

All participants (PGA, Non-PGA Professionals and Amateurs) may wear shorts anywhere on Club property during practice rounds only, with the approval of the Host Facility and without objection from the tournament sponsor.

\*Shorts will be a Bermuda style with solid traditional colors (no cargo, board, tennis or denim) at a length no shorter than slightly above the knee.

## **Tournament Rounds**

### **Professionals (PGA & Non-PGA):**

Must wear slacks and shall not wear shorts anywhere on Club property during tournament rounds or while practicing on the driving range, practice chipping or practice putting greens on tournament round days. No Male Professionals (PGA & Non-PGA) participant will be allowed to play Tournament round inappropriately attired.

Female PGA participants may wear culottes, walking shorts or golf skirts, which constitute acceptable clothing worn by women in connection with participation in professional golf tournaments.

**Note:** Tournament Pro-Ams are **not** considered practice rounds and therefore shorts will not be permitted for all Professionals (PGA & Non-PGA).

### **Amateurs:**

May wear shorts at all times: \*Shorts will be a Bermuda style with solid traditional colors (no cargo, board, tennis or denim) at a length no shorter than slightly above the knee. If, after being asked to comply with the policy, a player does not comply with any part of this policy, they will be removed from the competition, (no refund).

### **Caddies:**

While on the host facility property, caddies may wear either long pants or tailored solid colored knee length shorts. Blue jeans, cutoffs, T-shirts or shirts with no collar shall not be worn. Smooth rubber sole shoes are required. Golf shoes with traditional metal or soft spikes are prohibited. \*Shorts will be a Bermuda style with solid traditional colors (no cargo, board, tennis or denim) at a length no shorter than slightly above the knee.

## **Chapters and Division Dress Code:**

Male PGA participants in events conducted by the Chapter or Division may wear shorts anywhere on Club property during practice rounds, tournament rounds or while practicing on the driving range, practice chipping or practice putting greens on tournament round days with approval of the Host Facility and without objection from the tournament sponsor. Female PGA participants may wear culottes, walking shorts or golf skirts, which constitute acceptable clothing worn by women in connection with participation in professional golf tournaments.

\*Shorts will be a Bermuda style with solid traditional colors (no cargo, board, tennis or denim) at a length no shorter than slightly above the knee.

It is important to check the tournament information page when registering for an event to determine whether shorts will be allowed or not. Players in violation of the policy will be asked to change should they not be in compliance.
