

Johnson Couldn't Believe City Golf Title

George Johnson was mad. He was disgusted and just plain frustrated.

"I couldn't make a putt." said the touring golf professional after completing his final round in the Atlanta City Open golf tournament at the Fairington Golf a n d Tennis

"I've played out here quite a few times, so you'd think I would make a few putts, but I didn't. I really thought I had a shot at this thing, but I blew

About 45 minutes later. Johnson was accepting the first-place prize check of \$300, and just couldn't believe he had won it.

"I NEVER thought my two

rounds (76-72) would win," said Johnson, "I just didn't believe four-over-par would be good enough to win. I figured would have to shoot a 70 today to even have a chance. Then when I missed that short putt on the 18th. I was sure I was out of it."

What Johnson didn't take into account is that everyone else was also mad, disgusted and frustrated, and ended with scores much worse than his.

First day co-leader Richard Fuller fired a closing 77 for a 149 total, one back of Johnson. Amateur Charles Harrison. who shared the opening-round lead with Fuller, skied to a 79. Harrison had an atrocious start, bogeving two of the first three holes, and then closed with three bogevs in his last four holes.

Johnson is currently 65th on the PGA money list with a total of some \$36,000 in prize money, but he has two more chances to crack the top 60 and the exemption list for next year.

JOHNSON will play in the \$125,000 Heritage Golf Classic at Hilton Head, S.C. Nov. 23-26, then finish up in the \$150,-000 Walt Disney World Open in Lake Buena Vista, Fla., Nov. 30-Dec. 3.
