

Hot-Putting Wayne Yates Wins 5th Atlanta Open

Wayne Yates has always been regarded as a good putter. Tuesday he proved just how good.

The touring pro from Tam-O'Shanter Country Club sank three birdie putts of 20 feet or better on the last three holes and won a record fifth Atlanta Open title.

Yates' two-day 70-68-138 at the par-72 Snapfinger Woods Golf Club course was one shot better than amateur Danny Yates, who had a 73-66-139 and bogied the last hole after a fabulous final round that included four straight birdies at one point.

"I want to thank someone up above," said the winner following his final hole putting heroics. "I really wanted another win because Gene

Dalhbender had also won four titles."

Emory Lee and Jim Grant tied for third at 140. First-round leader Jim Causey blew to a 77 after a 68 and finished way back.

Yates won \$1,000 for first place.
