

Stacy Takes First Place In Tourney

McDONOUGH — Savannahian Tom Stacy fired a two-day total of 137 to nail down the \$1,000 first place scholarship at the fourth annual PGA Junior Golf Championship at Green Valley Country Club here Thursday.

The \$500 second prize was won by Marty Echols of Augusta, in a sudden death playoff against Atlanta's John Bodin. Bob Sams finished fourth.

In the 15-16 age group it was Dick Ravage of Atlanta. His 146 total was one better than Augusta's Henry Clausson (147). Skip Talbert, representing Houston Lakes County Club in Perry was third with 148. Steve Novak of Sandy Run, Warner Robins, had a 150 total and Randy Elliott, representing Idle Hour, finished with a 151. Elliott was tied for the lead in the 15-16 group after the first round with a 73.

Another Savannahian, John Stacy, took the 13-14 bracket title in a sudden death playoff against John Barnes of Atlanta. Both finished regulation play with 149s. Joe Kaney was third and Jim Barnes finished fourth.

The scholarships were furnished by the Georgia section of the PGA.
