Stan Gann Jr. of Kathleen won the overall boys title Wednesday at the Georgia PGA Junior Championships at the Canterbury Golf Club. The event was shortened to 27 holes due to rain. Gann shot a 4-under 32-70—102 to win by two strokes. Gann advances to the national championships on Aug. 23-26 at the PGA national course in Palm Beach Gardens, Fla. **Sean McGenity** of Macon was third overall and second in the 14-15 division with a 36-69—105. **Josh Blackmon** of Warner Robins was tied for 21st (42-70—112), **Scott Todd** of Vidalia was tied for 21st (36-76—112), **Cameron Meyer** of Warner Robins was tied for 26th (36-77—113) and **Kevin Crosby** of Bonaire was tied for 33rd (37-77—114). In the boys 12-13 division, **Tommy Branch** of Vidalia was second with a 38-38—76, **David Robinson** of Sandersville was 10th (43-44—87) and **Zach Blackmon** of Warner Robins tied for 12th (45-47—92).

GANN AND REGISTER CAPTURE MAXFLI GPGA JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP

Stan Gann, Jr. of Kathleen and Kristen Register of Roswell, captured the Maxfli Georgia PGA Junior Championship at Canterbury Golf Club.

Gann, 17, shot a final round 70 for a 27-hole total of 4-under par 102 and 2-shot victory over Stephen Sams of Canton. Register, 17, shot a final round 74 for a 27-hole total of 111 and a 3-shot margin over Mackenzie Cato of Duluth.

The Maxfli Georgia PGA Junior was shortened to 27-holes due to heavy rain that put four hole undewater.

By winning the boys and girls division, Gann and Register qualified for the Maxfli PGA Junior Championship finals to be played at PGA National Golf Club in Palm Beach Gardens, Fla., August 23-26.
