SCURLOCK, SIRMONS WIN MAXFLI JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP

YOUNG HARRIS, Ga. -- Brian Scurlock of Augusta and Summer Sirmons of Cuthbert are the winners of the boys' and girls' divisions at the Maxfli Junior Championship at Brasstown Valley Resort. Scurlock, 17, shot a final round 4-under par 68, the lowest competitive round ever at Brasstown Valley. Scurlock also shot the lowest qualifying round of any junior in the field, a 70 at the University of Georgia.

In addition to winning the Georgia PGA Maxfli Junior crown, Scurlock placed in the top ten in both the 1995 North- South Junior and the 1996 Taylor Made Junior at Pine Isle.

Sirmons, 16, won the girls' division after shooting a 12-over par 156. Sirmons shot the lowest rounds on both days (76-80), and was the only female competitor to shoot even par on nine holes (35 on the back nine Monday). Sirmons also placed second in the GSGA Girls' State Championship.

Scurlock and Sirmons now advance to the Maxfli Junior PGA Championship in Palm Beach Gardens, Florida August 22-25.
