On that abbreviated 18-hole basis, Marc Blumberg of Rome was declared winner with a twounder 70 recorded on Tuesday. Bo Trotter of Columbus was second a shot behind and Elliott Kirwin, also of Columbus, finished third at 72.

Eddie Causey of Warner Robins, Lyn Lott of Douglas and Tom Callaway of Albany all had posted 74's in the first round and were thus deadlocked for fourth place. Rounding out the top-10 came Bolling DuBose III of Athens, Tommy Valentine of Gainesville, Robert Brown of Dublin and Bobby Taylor of Columbus, all with 76's.

Blumberg's win also earned him a \$1,000 college scholar-The Pinetree Country ship. Club tournament—supposedly 36 holes-was sponsored by the Georgia State PGA.
