

Pomeroy Wins State PGA Crown

AUGUSTA, Ga., Oct. 27 (AP)—Ewing Pomeroy of Atlanta sunk a five-foot putt on the 19th hole to defeat Charley Harper of Columbia for the Georgia Professional Golfers Assn. championship Thursday at the Augusta Country Club.

Harper, who was two up at one stage of the match, had to sink a 12-foot birdie putt on the 18th green to send the match into overtime. Both players had regulation figures of 72 for the 18 holes.

Harper reached the finals of the tournament by defeating Augusta's Frank Carney, 4 and 3 in the morning round and Pomeroy tripped Broyles Plemmons of Valdosta, 2 and 1.

Richard Beckman of Marietta defeated Bud Fonts of Savannah in the consolation bracket, 3 and 2.

On the extra hole, Pomeroy hit a beautiful eight iron shot to the green and was left with an eight-foot birdie putt, which he made.
